Dear Friends,



We started 2024 laser-focused on ensuring that frontline community health workers were supplied, supervised, salaried, skilled and sustained, the highlight of which was an invitation from the Ministry of Health to draft policy for the President to formalize CHWs here in Indonesia. Meanwhile, we set off to unlock as much village-level government funding as possible across our five Center of Excellence districts. We bet big and we won. Our team signed 59 village-level MOUs worth more than \$188,000

USD in village-level government funding.

Deep Dive: Lights...Camera...Action

A team of young filmmakers from the United States travelled with the team to Komodo National Park to see how the 1000 Days Fund addresses stunting and chronic malnutrition in some of the most rural and remote islands in Indonesia.

The documentary filmmakers followed the 1000 Days Fund team as they worked hand-in-hand with community health workers to deliver first 1000 days messages and provide access to mothers who might never otherwise have heard. The film, slated for release before the end of the year will be screened in Indonesia and beyond in an effort to shine a light on the injustice that is stunting and chronic malnutrition.

Preliminary data suggests a dramatic decrease in stunting rates between 1000 Days Fund districts and control Districts. In fact, 1000 Days districts perform 5.25 times better than control districts, with regard to health outcomes.


"This is a really big deal," says Dr. Rindang Asmara, the COO of 1000 Days Fund. "It's the first time we can say that something as simple as training a community health worker and giving her the tools and confidence she needs, will improve stunting outcomes for generations and also help with poverty alleviation, which is an enormous finding,"



Breastfeeding Rates

Analysis of government data reveals **exclusive breastfeeding rates are 11% higher** in Stunting Center of Excellence districts.

Graphical diagnostics for parallel trends



Using Diff-in-Diff estimation, preliminary findings indicate the intervention district (SCE) shows a 11% higher coverage of exclusive breastfeeding compared to other districts in NTT. Not only is the rate higher, but exclusive breastfeeding in the SCE district continues to increase even when a significant decline is detected in other districts.

Research Advisory Board: A Master's Class for 1000 Days

Q1 marked the first face-to-face meeting of the 1000 Days Fund Research Advisory Board. The RAB provides expert advice to the 1000 Days Fund on the identification and prioritization of research topics, as well as research funding opportunities. Its input helps to enhance the quality of both the research process and the research findings through eliciting a broad spectrum of experiences and views.

RAB members are experts in their area and are well placed to recognize emerging research ideas and opportunities to provide advice regarding the research implications of a range of strategic stunting, malnutrition and community health worker and policy issues. Against this backdrop, **Dr. Zulfiqar Bhutta** stayed in Bali an extra day and spent the day with the team allowing us to pepper him with questions, everything from deworming meds impact on linear growth to why RCTs rarely represent the benefits of water and sanitation.

What Does **Scale** Mean to **1000 Days?**

Something has scaled when it has reached a million people

But a million might be just the start

Scale means exponential impact over time

Scale is a verb, not a noun: The trajectory & curve of impact are more important than the numbers.

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
